



SAIMI RUG



Necessary Material:

- 5 balls of MUSARA wool (to achieve finished measurements: 53x43cm)
- 2 double pointed knitting needles, size 7.
- 1 tapestry needle

Procedure:

To make this rug, we knit icords in three different lengths (50, 35 y 20 cm Fig.1.) The cords are then rolled and joined in a spiral (fig. 2) and placed in such a way as to achieve the desired colour combination. Next, they are sewn together (fig,3)

The first step is to make the icords. Cast on 5 stitches. In order to achieve the tubular shape with so few stitches,we simply join the first and the last stitch of our work. To do this, we take the work to the opposite end of the needle and start the next row using the wool which is on the left, as seen in figure 4.

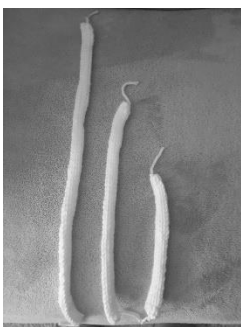
